**INTERIM FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER
FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF
LICENSE**

7 **INTRODUCTION**

8 The above-captioned matter came for discussion before the Arizona Medical Board
9 ("Board") at its August 23, 2018 meeting, where it had been placed on the agenda to
10 consider possible summary action against Subodh S. Shroff, M.D. ("Respondent"). Having
11 considered the information in the matter and being fully advised, the Board enters the
12 following Interim Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order for Summary Suspension
13 of License, pending a formal hearing or other Board action. A.R.S. § 32-1451(D).

14 **INTERIM FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of
16 the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.

17 2. Respondent is the holder of license number 37588 for the practice of
18 allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.

19 3. The Board initiated case number MD-18-0726A after receiving notification
20 that Respondent may have a health condition that impairs his ability to safely practice
21 medicine.

22 4. Based on the information received during the investigation, the Executive
23 Director issued an Interim Order for Physician Health Program Assessment on August 8,
24 2018. Respondent failed to complete the Assessment as required by the Order.

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1 3. Based on the foregoing Interim Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the public
2 health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency action. A.R.S. § 32-1451(D).

3 **ORDER**

4 Based on the foregoing Interim Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, set forth
5 above,

6 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

7 1. Respondent's license to practice allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona,
8 License No. 37588, is summarily suspended. Respondent is prohibited from practicing
9 medicine in the State of Arizona and is prohibited from prescribing any form of treatment
10 including prescription medications or injections of any kind.

11 2. The Interim Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law constitute written notice
12 to Respondent of the charges of unprofessional conduct made by the Board against
13 Respondent. Respondent is entitled to a formal hearing to defend these charges as
14 expeditiously as possible after the issuance of this Order.

15 3. The Board's Executive Director is instructed to refer this matter to the Office
16 of Administrative Hearings for scheduling of an administrative hearing to be commenced
17 within sixty days from the date of the issuance of this Order, unless stipulated and agreed
18 otherwise by Respondent. A.R.S. § 32-1451(D).
